INSTRUCTIONS

1. Find the amount of the fee(s) you must pay in the table above.
2. **Deposit the exact fee IN CASH IN EURO at the cashier at the CSOB bank.**

3. Get a receipt in your name showing the fee(s) paid in the correct currency into the account at the bank. Variable symbol is facultative (passport number).
4. Make a copy of the original receipt for your records as the **original** must be submitted along with the application. We do not accept receipts for less than the exact amount of the fee(s) in the table above. We will not refund overpayments.
(Visa section of the Embassy of Canada issues a receipt of fee payment that each applicant can file for his/her own accounting purposes. This receipt is available upon collection of the passport(s)/by post along with the passport).

We do not accept bank transfers from other banks.

If you do not reside in the Czech Republic, you may pay by Canadian dollar certified cheque or money order. The financial instrument must be in Canadian dollars drawn on a Canadian bank, payable to *The Receiver General for Canada*. We will **not** accept financial instruments drawn on non-Canadian banks or in the wrong amount.
